This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No. 172, dated 24.08.2012, under Sections 420 and 120, Police Station Civil Lines Bathinda, District Bathinda along with all consequential proceedings on the basis of compromise dated 27.10.2014.

2. Vide order dated November 27, 2015 passed by this Court, parties were directed to appear before the Id. Magistrate for getting their statements recorded to its satisfaction, to know about the genuineness of the statements and that the same are not the result of any pressure or coercion.

3. As per the report received from the Id. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bathinda dated April 23, 2015, though Jaspal Singh,

Jagdev Singh and Harpreet Kaur appeared before the trial court but the petitioners namely, Kushpal Singh, Kamaljit Kaur and Manjeet Kaur did not turn up there.

4. Keeping in view those facts, Id. Magistrate reported that he is not satisfied that matter has been compromised between the parties.

5. In view of the report received, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he does not want to proceed with the instant petition and intends to withdraw the same but with liberty to file a fresh one.

6. Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty, as prayed for.
