The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No. 107 dated 04.09.2016, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 447, 354, 506 and 354-A(1) of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Sadhaura, District Yamuna Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of order dated 31.10.2016, the petitioners have joined the investigation and their custodial interrogation is not required, therefore, the said order granting them interim bail may be confirmed.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent-State, on instructions from the concerned Investigation Officer, submits that petitioners have joined the investigation and they are not required for the custodial interrogation.

In view of the facts that the petitioners are not required for the

custodial interrogation and have joined the investigation, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 31.10.2016 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i) (ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

Petition stands disposed of.
