AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This is a petition for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.39 dated 12.09.2016 registered under Sections 323, 324, 148, 149 IPC (later on Section 326 IPC has been added) at P.S. Old Shalley.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the injury attributed to the petitioner was simple in nature. Learned Addl. A.G has pointed out that it was a case where 03 persons had made concerted attack on the victim and serious injury was caused by Amritpal Singh and he is

absconding. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that even though the aforesaid Amritpal Singh has filed a petition for anticipatory bail, he would not press that petition and would surrender on or before 08.11.2016.

In view of this categoric understanding, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of interim bail to the petitioner. The petitioner is directed to appear before the Investigating Officer on 07.11.2016 he will be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. In case the aforesaid co-accused Amritpal Singh surrenders, the interim bail of the petitioner would be confirmed and if he does not surrender as undertaken today by the petitioner,, this petition would be deemed to be dismissed.

Petition stands disposed of.
