The petitioners are ladies who had allegedly, along with three other co-accused, broken the lock of house of complainant Rattan Singh and damaged the wall adjacent to their house and committed theft of goods kept by the complainant in the house besides hurling threats.

With the assistance of the State counsel, I have gone through the police file and I am of the opinion that no specific injury or role has been attributed to the petitioners who are ladies.

In view of above circumstances, the petitioners can be granted the concession of bail. The petition is allowed. It is ordered that in the event of arrest, the petitioners will be released on bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer subject to the conditions that the petitioners will join investigation as and when required by the Investigation Agency by issuing written notice giving atleast one day time to the petitioners and that they will not tamper with the evidence or hamper investigation in any manner. The petitioners will neither indulge in any act qua the complainant nor will give any threat to the complainant.
