Prayer is for grant of regular bail on behalf of the petitioner in case FIR No. 135, dated 05.12.2014, for the offences punishable under Sections 22/61/85 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act and Section 427 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Mantiana, District Hoshiarpur.

As per allegations, recovery of 260 grams of intoxicant powder was made from the conscious possession of the petitioner/accused. The said quantity concededly is commercial in nature.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has been heard.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by HC Ranjit Singh, submits that out of nine prosecution witnesses, six witnesses have since been examined.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

It is hoped that the conclusion of trial would not be unnecessarily delayed.
