Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.20 dated 1.2.2015 under Sections 307/511/436/380/457/427/506/148/149 IPC registered at Police State Jhabhal, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that co-accused of the petitioner namely Gurinder Singh @ Gobindi, who was similarly situated with the petitioner, has been admitted on regular bail by this Court vide order dated 4.8.2016 passed in CRM-11618-2016 *Gurinder Singh alias Gobindi v. State of Punjab* whereas another co-accused Simarjit Singh @ Ghullu has been admitted on regular bail vide order dated

4.10.2016 passed by this Court in CRM-M-32900-2016 *Simarjit Singh @ Ghullu v. State of Punjab*.

Learned State counsel does not dispute the aforesaid facts and states that the allegations against the petitioner are similar to those of his co-accused.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the admitted position of the parties that the co-accused of the petitioner, who were similarly situated with the petitioner, have already been admitted on regular bail, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner-Jobanjit Singh is admitted on regular bail, subject to furnishing of his bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Tarn Taran.

It is made clear that observations made hereinabove shall not be construed as any expression on the merits of the case.
