This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.164 dated 13.12.2015 registered under Sections 307/148/149 IPC and Sections 25/54/59 of Arms Act at Police Station Nurpur Bedi, District Rupnagar.

Learned counsel states that the story in the FIR itself shows up its falsity. He further states that the petitioner has been in custody for almost seven months and in any case the injured has been discharged long back from the hospital.

Learned Additional Advocate General has denied the fact that the FIR is false but has accepted the other avements.

Be that as it may, keeping in view the above facts and the period of incarceration already suffered by the petitioner, without going into

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the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Ordered accordingly.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
