This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C praying for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.62 dated 21.09.2011, under Sections 406, 420 IPC, registered at Police Station, Noormahal, District District Jalandhar (Rural).

On 09.11.2015, while issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court:-

“The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.62, dated 21.09.2011, under Sections 406/420 IPC,

registered at Police Station Noormahal, District Jalandhar.

Counsel would argue that during the course of investigation, the present petitioners have been found innocent and it is only by virtue of an application under Section 319 Cr.P.C. having been allowed that the petitioners have been summoned as additional accused. It has further been submitted that co-accused, namely, Surinder Pal Singh @ Shinda has already been granted the concession of pre-arrest bail.

Notice of motion, returnable for 08.01.2016.

In the eventuality of the petitioners duly appearing before the trial Court on the date already fixed, they shall be entitled to ad interim protection as regards arrest subject to the satisfaction of the trial Court.”

Learned State counsel upon instructions from SI Jagdish Kumar, would apprise the Court that in pursuance to the order passed by this Court, the petitioners have duly appeared and put in appearance before the trial Court and have been admitted to interim bail subject to its satisfaction.

Petitioners having already joined trial proceedings, the petition is allowed, Order dated 09.11.2015, passed by this Court, is made absolute.
