This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.241 dated 06.08.2016 registered under Sections 420 IPC Sections 15(2), 15(3) of Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 at P.S. Chandhuth, Palwal.

After arguing for some time, the learned counsel for the petitioner states that he does not wish to press this petition on merits but liberty may be granted to the petitioner to surrender before the Court below and shall move

an application for regular bail and the Court may be directed to decide the said application expeditiously.

I find this to be a fair request. Consequently this petition is dismissed. If the petitioner surrenders before the Court on or before 15.11.2016 and moves an application for regular bail, the same shall be decided by the Court in accordance with law expeditiously, but in any case on or before 19.11.2016.
