Through the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks a direction to the police authorities to register FIR on the basis of the complaint Annexure P6, submitted to the Senior Superintendent of Police, S.A.S. Nagar, intimating that building of the petitioner had been given for hostel purposes to respondent no.5 Gurfateh Singh @ Rs.2 lac per month vide agreement which was for the period from 1.7.2015 to 31.5.2016. The said hostel had been vacated in March 2016 without paying the electricity bill and after causing damage. An unidentified person had damaged the hostel doors, windows and water tank.

In this context, I have carefully gone through the allegations in representation Annexure P6, dated 5.7.2016, submitted by the petitioner to the Senior Superintendent of Police, S.A.S. Nagar. The specific day, date and time of commission of any cognizable offence by respondent no.5, has not been mentioned, as such, no direction for registration of FIR on the basis of complaint Annexure P6, can be issued. The dispute appears to be between the landlord and tenant in which damage is alleged to have been caused to the building.

I have considered the request of the petitioner that in view of allegation in representation Annexure P6, dated 5.7.2016, that threat had been given to the petitioner, protection order is required to be passed and legal action is required to be taken under appropriate sections.

This petition is disposed of observing that in case detailed particulars of alleged criminal intimidation or any specific overt act attributed to any specific person is brought to the notice of the competent police official in accordance with law and same is not considered within reasonable time, it will be open to the petitioner to approach this Court again.
