Report dated 02.02.2016 sent by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class Jalandhar has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Maan Singh, Major Singh, Sandeep Lal, Gurpreet Lal, Deep Singh, Sandeep, Swaranjeet Singh as well as of complainant Prabhjot and Kamaljit Kaur it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that the offences are not heinous in nature and that parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052**, FIR No.102 dated

03.06.2015 under Sections 324,323,506,148,149 IPC, Police Station, Adampur, District Jalandhar and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioners.
