The petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482

Notice of motion.

Mr.Chander Shekhar Singhal, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondent Nos.4 and 5. The parents of the girl are also present. They have already had a meeting with the girl for almost 1½ hours in the Court and despite persuasion, the girl had been persisting to live with the husband. She does not want to stay with her parents, though an assurance has been given that they would marry her with the same boy.

The petitioners are stated to be major as per their date of birth reflected in the Aadhar cards and 10th class certificates (Annexures P-1 to P-4). They have solemnized marriage on 19.10.2016 against the wishes of their parents. Factum of marriage has been pleaded with reference to photographs (Annexure P-6).

Petitioners have an apprehension at the hands of private respondent Nos.4 and 5 and in this regard, they have submitted a representation dated 25.10.2016 (Annexure P-7) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Ambala-respondent No.2, but no action has been taken so far.

The present petition is disposed of with direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Ambala-respondent No.2 to look into the representation of the petitioners and decide the same and if required, provide the protection to the life and liberty of the petitioners by providing adequate security.

The crl. misc. petition stands disposed of with the above direction.
