Kuldip Singh, J. (Oral):

Present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No.147 dated 11.8.2014 under Sections 406, 420 IPC, registered at Police Station Chamkaur Sahib, District Rupnagar.

Report of learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Rupnagar received. The learned Magistrate has recorded the statements of the parties and has reported that the parties have effected the compromise without any threat, coercion or undue influence and with their free will and consent. It is further reported that the compromise is for the benefit of both the parties.

In view of the compromise effected between the parties, FIR No.147 dated 11.8.2014 under Sections 406, 420 IPC, registered at Police Station Chamkaur Sahib, District Rupnagar, along with consequential proceedings, stands quashed.

The petition is accordingly allowed.
