INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory/interim anticipatory bail in case FIR No.156 dated 04.04.2016, registered at Police Station Central Faridabad, under Sections 419, 420, 467, 471, 506 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Vikas Chopra, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana has accepted notice on behalf of the respondent-State. Mr. Shiv Kumar, Advocate has appeared and filed power of attorney on behalf of the complainant. Same is taken on record.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner; learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for complainant and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the petitioner was granted interim

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bail upto 29.10.2016 vide order dated 28.09.2016 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Faridabad. It has been brought into notice that application for extension of interim bail has already been dismissed. It has also been brought into notice that interim bail was granted on the basis of statement given by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner would deposit the amount of ₹2 crores with bank interest till 29.10.2016. However, the petitioner has neither deposited the amount, nor surrendered after the grant of interim bail.

In view of above, no ground is made out for the grant of anticipatory/interim bail. Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
