The petitioner is alleged to have escaped leaving the pillion rider Vikram Singh and his motorcycle with 5 Kgs of poppy husk.

Pursuant to the interim order, the petitioner has joined investigation. It is apparently improbable that the petitioner escaped in presence of police officials. It will certainly be a debatable issue whether the petitioner can be said to be in exclusive possession of poppy husk which is recovered from his co-accused.

Without expression of any opinion on merits, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of the arresting officer subject to the conditions that the petitioners will join investigation as and when required and will not tamper with the evidence or hamper investigation in any manner.
