JASPAL SINGH, J.

This petition has been preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No. 88, dated 10.07.2005, under Sections 304-A, 337, 338 and 379 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar, Kapurthala, Punjab (Annexure P-1) on the basis of compromise along with all consequential proceedings arising out of the same.

2. In compliance of order dated February 02, 2015, report of Id. Judicial Magistrate has been received, in which, it has been categorically observed that parties have genuinely compromised the

matter. Even otherwise, matter involved is personal in nature, which has been amicably put at rest.

3. In view of the above I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for their benefit and will bring peace and harmony between them.

4. Consequently, instant petition stands allowed and FIR No. 88, dated 10.07.2005, under Sections 304-A, 337, 338 and 379 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar, Kapurthala, Punjab and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua the petitioner.
