The present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of concession of regular bail to the petitioner in case First Information Report No.389 dated 14.05.2016 under Section 20 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 registered at Police Station Jhajjar.

The accusation against the petitioner is that 850 grams of narcotic drug was recovered from him.

The submissions made by Mr. Sanjeev Kodan, learned counsel representing the petitioner and Mr. Sulinder Kumar, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana have been heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the recovery

for the last more than six months and the trial is still likely to take some time. Co-accused of the petitioner was enlarged on regular bail vide order of this Court dated 26.10.2016.

Considering the facts and circumstances and without going into the merits of the case, the petitioner who is in custody since 14.05.2016 and there appears no plausible ground to detain the petitioner further in custody, is admitted to regular bail during pendency of the trial, subject to his furnishing bail/ surety bonds to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate, Jhajjar.
