JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)

Prayer in this petition, filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., is for grant of anticipatory bail to both the ladies/petitioners/accused, namely, Santosh and Alka, who have been booked for having committed the offences punishable under Sections 307, 323, 506, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station City Rohtak.

It was contended that main injury is attributed to one Suresh @ Kalia, which has been opined to be dangerous to life. That apart, there is a version and cross-version of the occurrence.

Learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and their custodial interrogation is no longer required.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by A.S.I. Amar Singh, concedes the aforesaid factual position.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted by this Court, vide order dated 18.12.2015, is made absolute.
