Petitioner Narayan Singh has filed the present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 39 dated 24.11.2015, registered under Sections 323, 376, 498-A, 406, 506, 511 and 34 of the IPC at Women Police Station, Palwal Sadar, District Palwal.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is in custody since 08.06.2016 and the statement of prosecutrix/complainant as well as her father has been recorded. It is further contended that the trial is likely to take some time on account of the fact that out of total eleven witnesses, only two witness have been examined.

Mr. Sharad Kumar Yadav, DAG, Haryana, has appeared on behalf of respondent-State and contested the bail application.

In view of the fact that statement of the prosecutrix/complainant as

well as her father has been recorded and the petitioner is in custody since 08.06.2016 and further that the trial is likely to take some time, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner in custody furthermore.

Therefore, keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and without expressing any opinion on the merit of the case, the present petition is accepted and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/learned trial Court concerned.

Petition stands disposed of.
