By filing the present petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought interim bail for a period of four weeks in FIR No.287 dated 12.07.2016, registered under Sections 302, 323, 506 read with Section 34 IPC and Section 3 of the Scheduled Castes & the Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, at Police Station Sadar Hansi, District Hisar.

It is submitted that marriage of daughter of the petitioner has been fixed for 25.11.2016. The petitioner has to arrange the funds and perform important rituals and ceremonies in the marriage.

The learned State counsel, on instructions admits the factum of marriage.

Keeping in view above, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on interim bail for a period of four weeks on his furnishing requisite bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the releasing Court. The date to surrender is to be indicated by the releasing Court.
