## **ANITA CHAUDHRY, J. (ORAL)**

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 204 dated 18.07.2014 registered at Police Station Kundli, District Sonapat under Sections 365, 366, 376, 302, 494, 201 IPC read with Section 34 IPC.

Learned State counsel has placed on record copy of the statements as well as the zimni orders.

Heard. The petitioner is in custody since 22.07.2014. The prosecution has only examined 19 witnesses out of 32 witnesses. All the private witnesses except the complainant have turned hostile. The FIR has been registered after 5 years of the incident. The prosecution case hinges upon the disclosure statement made by the co-accused. Only the official witnesses remain to be examined.

Without commenting anything on the merits of the case and considering the fact that the trial will take time to conclude, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing local surety and adequate bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
