This order shall dispose of the aforesaid both the petitions.

The petitioners seek grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR
No.98, dated 11.6.2016, registered under Sections 324, 323, 148, 149,
326 of the IPC, at Police Station Baghapurana, District Moga.

Counsel for the petitioners has argued that the main accused
Roop Singh @ Jagroop Singh has been granted the concession of interim
anticipatory bail by the trial Court, vide order dated 23.11.2016.

Nachhattar Singh, has accepted this factual assertion.

Since the main accused has been granted interim bail and the allegations against the present petitioners are not so serious, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioners. Consequently, the petitioners are directed to appear before the Investigating Officer on 3.12.2016 or on any other day on which the Investigating Officer requires their presence, and in the event of their arrest, the petitioners shall be released on anticipatory bail by the Investigating Officer to his satisfaction subject to the compliance of the provisions as contained in Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.

The petitions stand disposed of.
