This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C
for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 49 dated
13.10.2016 under Sections 306 IPC at Police Station GRP, Sangrur.

As per the allegations, the petitioner had borrowed a
sum of ₹11 lacs and since she refused to return the same, the deceased

committed suicide.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that there is no evidence or material on record to show that the refusal of the petitioner was with intention or knowledge that this would result in the suicide by the deceased.

Learned counsel for the complainant and Mr. Ashish Sanghi, DAG., Punjab on instructions from ASI Paraminder Singh have stressed that there is a suicide note in which the deceased had mentioned that she is committing suicide only because the petitioner had not returned her money.

Be that as it may, in the circumstances, keeping in view the above facts, without commenting on the merits of the case, let the petitioner surrender before the Investigating officer on 21.11.2016 and the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and he shall remain bound by the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

Ordered accordingly.

Petition stands allowed.
