JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Prayer in this second petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, is for grant of anticipatory bail on behalf of the petitioner/accused-Balbir in case FIR No. 546, dated 16.09.2015, for offences punishable under Sections 307, 323, 506, 148, 149, of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station City Rohtak, District Rohtak.

It was contended that main injuries have been attributed to co-accused/non-applicant-Suresh @ Kalia. It was also submitted that only a vague allegation regarding petitioner also involved in causing injuries, has been made.

At the time of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to order dated 04.02.2016, passed by this Court, the petitioner has since joined the investigation and fully cooperated.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by ASI Amar Singh, does not refute the aforesaid factual position and further states that the petitioner is no longer

required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted to the petitioner by this Court's order dated 04.02.2016, is made absolute.
