This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 13 dated 25.1.2015 under Section 22/61/85 of NDPS Act at Police Station Jalandhar-City.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner could not appear on one date i.e. 9.3.2016 and thereafter he was arrested in another case and consequently the offence kept compounded itself and before that he had been appearing since the year 2015 and never mis-used the concession of bail.

Mr. Ashish Sanghi, DAG., Punjab, on instructions from the Head Constable Gurmeet Singh accepts these factual assertions.

Be that as it may, in the circumstances, keeping in view the above facts and the period of custody, without commenting on the

merits of the case, I do not think it appropriate to deny the concession of bail to the petitioner. The petitioner be released on regular bail to the satisfaction of the Trial court/Duty Magistrate.

Ordered accordingly.

Petition stands allowed.
