Kuldip Singh, J. (Oral):

Present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No.67 dated 13.9.2015 under Sections 323, 324, 341, 148, 149, 506, 427 and 326 IPC, registered at Police Station Fatehgarh Panjtoor, District Moga.

Report of learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Moga received. The learned Magistrate recorded the statements of the accused-petitioners as well as of the complainant and victim and has reported that the parties have effected compromise without any force, coercion or fraud with their own free will.

In view of the compromise effected between the parties, FIR No.67 dated 13.9.2015 under Sections 323, 324, 341, 148, 149, 506, 427 and 326 IPC, registered at Police Station Fatehgarh Panjtoor, District Moga along with consequential proceedings stands quashed.

The petition is accordingly allowed.
