Report dated 17.12.2015 sent by learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Dera Bassi has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Satwinder Singh @ Lutri, Sukhwinder Singh, Gurjit Singh, Gurwinder Singh @ Moti, Jagtar Singh and Harjit Singh as well as of complainant Malkhan Singh it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that the offences are not heinous in nature and that the parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052**, FIR No.43 dated 09.03.2013 under Sections 457,380 IPC, Police Station, Dera Bassi

District SAS Nagar and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
