Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.208 dated 26.11.2009, under Sections 457 and 380 IPC, registered at Police Station Patti, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is in custody from 13.9.2016 and co-accused namely Gurjant Singh, Prabhjit Singh @ Prabh and Mandeep Kumar though already convicted but their sentences have been reduced to undergone after remaining in custody for 5 months.

Learned State counsel has filed the custody certificate. Same is taken on record. Perusal of the same reveals that the petitioner is in custody

from 13.9.2016 i.e. about two months.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the custody of the petitioner and the fact that sentences of co-accused namely Gurjant Singh, Prabhjit Singh @ Prabh and Mandeep Kumar have already been reduced to undergone, the petition is **accepted**. The petitioner is admitted on regular bail on furnishing of his bail bonds and surety bonds subject to satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Tarn Taran.
