The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.691, dated 17.8.2015, registered under Sections 452, 395, 397, 420, 467, 468, 471 of the IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Model Town, Panipat.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that a similarly situated co-accused has been granted the benefit of regular bail.

Counsel for the respondent has accepted this but states that

only one witness remains to be examined and the prosecution will definitely conclude its entire evidence on the next date fixed i.e 21.11.2016 subject to the accused not obstructing the same.
