Petitioner seeks concession of regular bail in a case registered at the instance of Soil Conservator, Punjab to the effect that one cheque of Rs. 28,07,417/- of HDFC Bank had been fraudulently debited from the Bank and credited in the account of Guru Kirpa Chemicals by forging the signatures of Randhir Singh, Assistant Collector of Soil Conservation. Petitioner has been in custody with effect from 29.07.2016. Challan stands already presented. Charges having been framed, no witness has been examined. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody any longer.

The petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of

the trial Court subject to the condition that petitioner will not leave India without the permission of the trial Court.
