The petitioner has invoked the inherent jurisdiction of this Court by filing this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., seeking a direction to the official respondents to file final report under Section 173 (2) Cr.P.C.

The said direction is not permissible. In view of the judgment in Abhinandan Jha and others Vs. Dinesh Mishra, AIR

1968 SC 117, such a direction cannot be issued. However, on asking of the Court, learned State counsel on the instructions of ASI Gurmeet Singh informs that cancellation report has been prepared and presented before the Illaqa Magistrate and the same stands accepted. In case complainant has got any grievance of having not been issued any notice, it will be open to him to avail the legal remedy available to him.
