JASPAL SINGH, J.

This petition has been preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No. 94, dated April 29, 2012, under Sections 452, 323, 427, 506, 34 of IPC, registered at Police Station Kotwali Patiala, District Patiala (**Annexure P-1**) along with all consequential proceedings arising out of the same on the basis of compromise dated March 22, 2014 (**Annexure P-2**).

2. In compliance of order dated March 29, 2016, statement of the parties have been recorded by the trial Court. Report of

learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Patiala, has been received, in which, it has been categorically observed that parties have arrived at compromise with their free will, voluntarily, without any coercion or undue influence from any quarter. Even otherwise, matter involved is personal in nature, which has been amicably put at rest.

3. In view of the above, I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for their benefit and will bring peace and harmony between them.

4. Consequently, instant petition stands allowed and FIR No. 94, dated April 29, 2012, under Sections 452, 323, 427, 506, 34 of IPC, registered at Police Station Kotwali Patiala, District Patiala (**Annexure P-1**) and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua the petitioners.
