INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.183 dated 13.10.2015, registered at Police Station E-Division, Amritsar City, under Sections 420, 466, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the allegations, the present petitioner along with co-accused, Hardeep Singh, cheated the complainant to the tune of ₹9 lacs on the pretext of getting his son recruited in the Railway Department.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present

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case, nature and gravity of the offence and in view of the fact that the petitioner is required for custodial interrogation, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled for the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Dismissed.
