This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.72 dated 01.09.2016 registered under Sections 61/1/14 of Excise Act and Sections 21/22/61/85 of NDPS Act at Police Station Chattiwind, District Amritsar.

As per allegation 150 grams of intoxicating powder was seized from the petitioner. As per FSL report it contains Diazepam.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the commercial quantity is 500 grams which is accepted by the Assistant Advocate General.

As per the custody certificate the petitioner has undergone about three months of custody and no other case under NDPS Act is pending or decided against him.

Learned State counsel on instructions from H.C. Baljinder Singh has accepted these facts.

In the circumstances, I see no reason to dismiss the petition.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Ordered accordingly.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
