This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C praying for the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.126 dated 8.10.2015 under sections 420, 406, 120-B I.P.C, registered at Police Station, Division No.4, Jalandhar, District Jalandhar.

Suffice it to notice that the allegations primarily hinge on an agreement to sell dated 23.2.2015 with regard to the property in question.

The present petition had come up for preliminary hearing on 10.11.2015 and while issuing notice of motion petitioner was granted *ad interim* protection as regards arrest subject to her joining investigation.

Counsel for the petitioner would contend that after registration of the F.I.R a settlement has been arrived at between the parties.

Mr. G.P.S. Bal, Advocate who has put in appearance on behalf of the complainant states that he has no instructions with regard to any compromise that may have been effected.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Tarsem Singh would apprise the Court that the petitioner has since joined investigation. He further submits that a compromise deed had been furnished before the I.O and on the strength thereof a cancellation report has been prepared and which is still under process.

In view of the above, the prayer made in the present petition is accepted. Accordingly, the present petition is allowed. The order dated 10.11.2015, passed by this Court, is made absolute.

Petition disposed of.
