SNEH PRASHAR, J.

The present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (Cr.P.C.) for grant of concession of regular bail to the petitioner in case First Information Report No.55 dated 04.07.2014, under Sections 21,22,61 and 85 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act,1985 registered at Police Station, Jhandher, District Amritsar Rural.

Heard the submissions made by Mr. Rahul Makkar, Advocate representing the petitioner and Mr. Ankur Jain, AAG, Punjab, representing the State.

The allegation against the petitioner is that 200 grams of narcotic power was recovered from him. The petitioner is in custody since 09.02.2016 and the trial is still likely to take some time to

complete.

Learned State counsel has filed affidavit of Raja Navdeep Singh, Officiating Superintendent, Central Jail, Amritsar giving details of custody of the petitioner in the instant case. The same is taken on record.

Considering the facts and circumstances and without going into the merits of the case the petitioner is admitted to regular bail during pendency of the trial, subject to his furnishing bail/surety bonds, to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Amritsar.
