This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for
grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.193 dated

16.10.2015, registered under Sections 420, 408 IPC, at Police Station Phase-I, Mohali.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that pursuant to the previous orders the son of the petitioner No.1-Baljinder Singh has been arrested and the petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned Additional Advocate General on instructions from S.I. Ram Kishan has accepted this fact and stated that the petitioners are no more required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in the present case. Ordered accordingly.

Resultantly, the petition is allowed. In the event of arrest of the petitioners, they shall be released on bail by the Investigating Officer subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
