INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to protect their life and liberty and to provide adequate security to protect them from respondent Nos.4 to 8.

Notice of motion was issued and the directions were issued that respondent Nos.2 and 3 shall ensure that the petitioners are not harmed by the private respondents.

Today, learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for respondent No.5 have appeared.

Learned State counsel has stated that the petitioners have not approached the police for protection and they are absconding.

In view of above, without going into the validity of the marriage, the present petition is disposed of with the directions to the

petitioners to contact respondent Nos.2 and 3, who, after their satisfaction that the petitioners are actually facing threat, shall take necessary steps to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from private respondent Nos.4 to 8, as per law.

However, it is made clear that this order, in no way, will affect any other proceedings pending or to be filed against the petitioners etc., which are to be dealt with independently as per law.
