INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner has filed this second petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.64 dated 19.12.2014, registered at Police Station Dhilwan, District Kapurthala, under Sections 323, 324, 148, 149 and 326 IPC and Sections 307 and 325 IPC (added later on).

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the present petitioner has been named in the FIR. He is stated to be armed with '*datar*'. He has allegedly caused injury on the forehead of complainant-Jit Singh which has been declared dangerous to life.

Keeping in view the nature and gravity of the offence and in view of the facts that the present petitioner is required for custodial

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interrogation and he is the main accused, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled for the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
