TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA.J.

This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking the concession of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.121, dated 04.06.2015, under Sections 420/120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Jagraon, District Ludhiana Rural.

Suffice it to notice that the allegations made by the complainant are with regard to having been defrauded of a sum of Rs.20 lacs on the purchase of a horse and by stating that the horse was not of such high value.

While issuing notice of motion on 18.11.2015, the petitioner had been granted ad interim protection as regards arrest subject to his joining investigation.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Teja Singh would apprise the Court that the petitioner has since joined investigation.

It has also gone uncontroverted that co-accused Raju Khan and Mangal Khan @ Dev have been granted the concession of anticipatory bail by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Ludhiana in terms of order dated

29.07.2015 (Annexure P-3).

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed. Order dated 18.11.2015 passed by this Court is made absolute.
