Prayer in this petition, filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, who has been booked for having committed the offences punishable under Section 379 of the Indian Penal Code, in a case arising out of FIR No.131 dated 28.09.2015, registered at Police Station Khamano, District Fatehgarh Sahib (**Annexure P-1**).

Allegation is that accused has stolen certain agricultural implements allegedly owned by the complainant.

It was contended that even as per the case set out in the FIR, the said alleged stolen agricultural implements were never in the possession of the complainant.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by ASI Kewal Singh, concedes the aforesaid factual submission.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted by this Court, vide order dated 18.11.2015, is made absolute.
