Instant petition has been preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking directions to respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner as well her family members at the hands of respondents No.4 to 10 and for issuance of direction to respondent No.2 to carry out fair and impartial investigation in the incident taken place on 05.10.2015 as well as to decide the complaint dated 23.10.2015 (Annexure P-6) in accordance with law..

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Kirpal Singh has submitted that in FIR No. 94 dated October 09, 2015 under Sections 452, 323,

324, 325, 326, 295, 427, 148 and 149 IPC registered at Police Station Valtoha, District Tarn Taran investigation is almost complete and report under Section 173(2) Cr.P.C. could not be presented as proceedings under Section 182 Cr.P.C. have been initiated against six persons. He further submits that as far as cross version is concerned that has been found to be false and cancellation report has been prepared.

In view of the facts unfolded by learned State counsel, instant petition has rendered infructuous and as such, the same is disposed of.

However, petitioner shall be at liberty to have recourse to other remedies available to her under law.
