This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking the benefit of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.245 dated 25.9.2015 under sections 22, 61, 85 of N.D.P.S. Act, registered at Police Station, Kotwali Bathinda, District Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the parties have been heard.

As per prosecution version the alleged recovery from the conscious possession of the present petitioner is of 7 vials of Rexcof containing 100 M.L each. Concededly such quantity would not be construed as commercial quantity.

The petitioner is not stated to be involved in any other case under the N.D.P.S Act.

Without making any observations on merits, present petition is allowed. Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of C.J.M./Duty Magistrate, Bathinda.

Petition disposed of.
