ANITA CHAUDHRY, J(ORAL)

Through the instant petition, the petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.152 dated 06.07.2015, registered under Section 406, 498-A IPC, Police Station Zirakpur, District SAS Nagarm Mohali.

On the last date of hearing the petitioner has undertaken to compensate the complainant for the gold articles.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 04.11.2016 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and has cooperated.

Learned State counsel states that the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Looking to all these circumstances, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 04.11.2016 vide which the petitioner was directed to join the investigation is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

The petitioner would deposit a sum of Rs.2.5 lacs with the Trial Court before 30.01.2017 which shall be disbursed to the complainant and is in lieu of the gold.
