This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.25 dated 20.03.2014, under Sections 406/420/120B of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Mullepur, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

While issuing notice of motion, the following order was passed by this Court on 19.11.2015:

"It is inter alia argued that the only allegations against the petitioner are that he is witness to the agreement to sell in question, a pure civil dispute, and that the main accused Sukhbir Singh and others have already been allowed anticipatory bail by this Court vide order dated 16.02.2015 (Annexure P-4).

Notice of motion for 18th January, 2016.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the

petitioner shall be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of arresting/investigating officer. The petitioner shall, however, join the investigation as and when called for and shall also abide by the conditions specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Kulwant Singh has apprised the Court that the petitioner has since joined investigation. That apart the observations made by this Court and contained in the notice of motion order have gone un-rebutted.

Accordingly, petition is allowed. Order dated 19.11.2015, passed by this Court is made absolute.
