ANITA CHAUDHRY, J.

This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for directions to respondent No.3 to hold an enquiry in FIR No. 204 dated 10.11.2015, registered under Section 498-A IPC at Police Station Phase-I, SAS Nagar, Mohali and to add Sections 406 and 420 IPC. A further prayer is made to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner from the hands of respondents No.6 to 8.

State has filed the reply.

Learned State counsel submits that though the complaint had been given against eight persons, but the allegations against respondent No.6 were only found and respondents No.7 and 8 were found innocent and Section 406 IPC has been added. He further submits that during enquiry it was found that respondents No.7 and 8 had stayed away from the couple and the stay of the petitioner with them was only for a shorter period.

In view of this, no further directions are required to be passed.

The petition is disposed of. The petitioner may avail the remedies which are permissible under law.
