ANITA CHAUDHRY, J.

This petition has been filed seeking directions to respondents no.1 & 2 to arrest respondent nos.3 to 7.

An FIR had been lodged under Section 365 IPC on 25.04.2016. The FIR had been lodged by the petitioner's husband namely Manmohan Singh. They had been married in December, 2015. The wife was missing from the house and the husband came to know that Lachhman Singh had taken his wife away. He also found some cash and jewellery missing. The petitioner returned on her own and gave a complaint to the SSP (Annexure P-2) wherein she had disclosed that Lachhman Singh had taken her abroad and they had visited Malaysia, Thailand and Singapore and she had been drugged and had been raped.

The police has registered the FIR and are investigating. No directions are required to be given as it would amount to interference in the investigations.

The petition is dismissed in limine.
