Petitioners seek quashing of FIR No. 20 dated 29.06.2015 under Sections 325, 323, 34 IPC registered at Police Station Lakhewali District Sri Muktsar Sahib, Punjab on the basis of compromise having been arrived at between the parties.

The said FIR was registered at the instance of respondent No. 2 - Harbans Singh in a case of assault.

Without expression of any opinion on merits, it is sufficient to observe that parties appeared before the Illaqa Magistrate and got their statements recorded. As per the report received, the matter has been amicably settled.

In view of the Full Bench judgment of this Court in **“Kulwinder Singh vs. State of Punjab, 2007 (3) Recent Criminal Reports (P&H), 1052”**, I am of the opinion that on account of the matter having been amicably resolved between the parties, neither any useful

purpose will be served nor any fruitful result by trial would be achieved.

The petition is allowed. The aforesaid FIR and all the consequent proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise.
