The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.174, dated 4.12.2014, registered under Sections 420, 120-B of the IPC, at Police Station Sadar, District Hoshiarpur.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner has been in custody for 1 year and 2 months; challan has been presented and it is a case of Magisterial trial.

Learned Addl. AG Punjab has accepted these factual

assertions.

In these circumstances, without commenting upon the merits of the case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.
