Petitioner, Sonu has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.570 dated 07.11.2015, registered at Police Station Ganaur, District Sonipat, under Sections 394 and 397 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act

Notice of motion has been issued in this case. Learned Deputy Advocate General, Haryana has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that FIR, in the present case, has been got registered by Pawan Kumar with the averments that on 06.11.2015, at about 8.00/8.30 p.m, when he was coming to his house from Murthal on his

motor-cycle, four young boys came from front side on a motor-cycle without number plate and intercepted him. One of the boys pointed pistol at the complainant; second boy took out his purse whereas the third boy hit the *butt* of pistol on his nose and the fourth boy snatched his bag containing his QID, other documents of the company, driving licence, registration certificate of motor-cycle, ATM Card, PAN Card and cash amount of ₹.3,800/-.

In the present case, challan has been presented, however, charges have not been framed. Case is at the initial stage and no witness has been examined so far. There is every apprehension that if the petitioner is granted the concession of bail, he may tamper with the evidence.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case and in view of the nature and gravity of the offence, no ground for grant of regular bail to the petitioner is made out at this stage.

Dismissed.
